Conclusion

-In the EU/EEA, only three non-HUS STEC cases were reported to have fallen ill within the last 10 days (16 July – 25 July), all in Germany. These are three probable cases, not yet confirmed with STEC O104.

-The last known date of illness onset in a patient with confirmed STEC O104 was 7 July 2011.

-The last reported date of illness onset among all cases was 17 July 2011.
