



Optional Home Self-isolation Procedures











The doctor will examine the active case and assess the patient's health status.



The optional home self-isolation instructions will be explained to the active case. The active case will be provided with medical supplies (masks, gloves, sterilizers, and medications if required).



The active case will wear an electronic bracelet to ensure non-violation of the optional home self-isolation procedures.

Periodic follow-up



The active case will be followed-up regularly by a representatives from the Ministry of Health via phone, and the (BeAware) application.



If symptoms appear, the, active case will be referred to an isolation and treatment center for the necessary examinations or treatment.






After the optional 10-day home self-isolation period has ended, the active case must go to the nearest health center and submit the declaration form.



The electronic bracelet shall be removed by the representatives of the Ministry of Health and the self-isolation status shall end.



In case any symptoms appear within 72 hours after the end of the optional home self-isolation period, medical advice must be sought from the health center.
