
Requirements



Provide vaccination certificates recognised by those countries

Will be provided with a card proving the acceptance of their vaccination status

The above requirements do not apply to passengers between the ages of 6 to 17, and those not vaccinated or recovered





The National Medical Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus:

Passengers will continue to undergo the required PCR testing, self-isolate until a negative result is reported, and test again on their 5th and 10th day of stay


