





## The National Medical Taskforce:

In line with what has been previously announced on 31 January, the Kingdom of Bahrain will adopt the Green Alert Level starting from 15 February 2022

in accordance with the COVID-19 Alert Level Traffic Light System-

Some procedures within the Green Alert Level have been updated:



A return to 100% capacity for all indoor facilities, including cinemas, playgrounds, entertainment centres, events, conference halls, and public attendance at sports events, individuals would not need to present a Green Shield vaccine pass. Masks wearing indoors will continue to be compulsory



There is no increase in the number of cases that require medical treatment or are in intensive care



This is due to the success of the Kingdom's National Vaccination Campaign



The Kingdom continues its preparedness, including maintaining medical capacities across its testing, isolation and treatment centres, to address any further challenges that may arise or pandemic developments that may occur
